WARRANT OF THE WARNER VILLAGE WATER DISTRICT 2022 ANNUAL MEETING THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the inhabitants of the Warner Village Water District in the Town of Warner, in Merrimack County, in said State, qualified to vote in District affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet in the Town Hall in said Warner on Tuesday, the Fifteenth day of March next, at 7:00 o'clock in the evening to act upon the following subjects:

- 1. To choose one Commissioner for three years.
- 2. To choose a Clerk and a Treasurer for the ensuing year.
- 3. To see if the Warner Village Water District will vote to raise and appropriate \$1,798,000 to cover the cost of testing and engineering, construction of a ground water discharge system for the District and to authorize the issuance of not more than \$1,798,000 of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) and to authorize the Commissioners to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon; further to authorize the Commissioners to apply for, obtain and accept Federal, State, or other aid, grants, gifts or other forms of assistance which may be available for said project and further, to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,500 for the first year's bond payment. Recommended by the Commissioners and by the Budget Committee. (3/5 ballot vote required).
- 4. To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate the Budget Committee recommended sum of four hundred ninety-one thousand two hundred fifty six dollars (\$491,256.00) for the operation, maintenance and improvement of the District's water and sewer systems. (Recommended by the District Commissioners and the Budget Committee).
- 5. To see if the District will vote to raise the District's water and sewer rates 4% from \$5.88 to \$6.12 per thousand gallons metered for water rates and from \$12.46 to \$12.96 per thousand gallons metered for sewer rates.
- 5. To transact any other business that may legally come before the said meeting.
