
Article 05 Construction Project Loan

Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,615,000 (Two Million, Six Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars) for the purpose of making repairs, rebuilding, and improving certain Town roads, including the drainage of such roads, including Schoodac Road, Poverty Plains Road, Pumpkin Hill Road, Mason Hill Road, North Village Road, and other such Town roads the Select Board determines need such work, and to authorize the issuance of not more than \$2,615,000 (Two Million Six Hundred and Fifteen Thousand Dollars) bond or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33); and to authorize the Select Board to issue and negotiate such bonds and notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon; and further, to raise and appropriate the sum of up to \$25,000 (Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars) through taxation for the interest payment on the bonds and notes.
