

Minutes of the Meeting of the
Warner Village Water District Commissioners
3:30 P.M. on
April 23, 2025 at the Treatment Plant

Present: Dan Lavoie, and Herm Blanchette, Commissioners; Ray Martin, Administrator; and Jim McLaughlin, Clerk.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

The minutes of the Commissioners' regular meeting held on April 9, 2025 were revised to show that the person being considered for a backup license to the treatment plant was formerly employed at Sunapee, not currently. With this correction, the minutes of April 9 were approved.

Administrator's Report

Ray advised the Commissioners that due to some miscommunication between the District, Horizon Engineering and DPC, involving payment for services, Horizon came up short and is requesting a payment of \$23,700 from the District. While John Warzocha claims an even greater shortage of funds owed his company, the commissioners agreed to pay the \$23,700 to Horizon and not to honor his request for additional funds, citing certain mitigating factors.

The Commissioners discussed the need to carry out tests of the copper content in the plant's effluent to establish a more comprehensive data set for this element. This set should also include data from Concord resulting from their test of our sludge.

Ray said that ten new meters have been received and 4 or 5 have been installed.

Ray also reported that a 48-unit building is being considered by the Zoning Board at Exit 9 next to Dunkin Donuts. The Commissioners discussed the significance of such a development and its beneficial effect on the District's financial picture in light of the treatment plant reconstruction as a result of the copper rule.

The Commissioners discussed the matter of the letter to be sent to influential persons at State and federal levels looking for relief in the face of the new copper limit on treated effluent. Ray said he would contact Charlie Albano for his assistance on this.

The meeting adjourned at 4:30 P.M.
