Approval of Meeting Minutes

The minutes of the meeting of the Commissioners on January 28, 2026 were approved as submitted.

District Business

The Commissioners met with Mr. Milender about a wastewater problem he has experienced at his house.

Ray reported on the progress being made by the consultant, DPC Engineering. The pilot tests of copper removal systems are set for the end of March into early April. However there seems to be a problem with running the two systems side-by-side because of the low flows being processed at the plant. This suggests that the two will have to be run individually. There is a question as to how this can be accomplished since each system is to run for six weeks. By running them one at a time, the total time will stretch to twelve weeks. No resolution to this issue has been resolved.

DPC is moving along on the project. An electrical engineering firm has been selected.

With regard to licensed personnel, Chuck has made arrangements to take his Operator II license and Tyler will take his first license test in December.

The meeting adjourned at 4:10 P.M.
